Stratford Drive, Bourne End

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Buckinghamshire Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 90 of the Highways Act 1980, The Highways (Traffic Calming) Regulations 1999 and all other enabling powers in conjunction with the developer Croudace Homes Ltd proposes to construct a raised table in the publicly maintained section of Stratford Road, Bourne End.

The raised table in the publicly maintained highway is to be constructed (60m in length, 75mm max height) at the following location:

- (i) At a point approx. 74 metres north of the junction of Stratford Road and Town Lane (A4094).

A copy of the plan showing the road to be affected and the location of the Road Hump may be inspected by appointment during normal office hours at Walton Street Offices, Aylesbury.
